With a background in economics and law, Tom Campbell has dedicated his professional career to public service as an educator, a State Senator, a five-term Member of Congress, and as California State Finance Director. During his tenure as State Finance Director, California's budget was balanced with no tax increases, no new borrowing, and no accounting gimmicks. Having received many accolades for his public service, Tom was named by the National Taxpayers Union Foundation as the most frugal member of the 102nd Congress, and was named by the *California Journal* as the #1 State Senator, the Senate's Best Problem-Solver, and the Most Ethical State Senator. Currently the inaugural Presidential Fellow and Visiting Professor of Law at Chapman University School of Law, Campbell served for 5 years as the Dean of the Haas School of Business at the University of California, Berkeley, and for 19 years as a Stanford University professor. Graduated Magna Cum Laude from Harvard Law in 1976, Campbell also earned his PhD in Economics in 1980. His free market economics training has resulted in a life-long commitment to limited government and greater individual liberty. As a candidate for the GOP nomination for the office of Governor, Campbell will share his perspectives on California's future.
